**Summary:** Eliminates monitoring entity from impaired health professional program. Requires program to report professional's participation in program and noncompliance with program directly to professional's licensing board. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

**Summary:** Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to convene work group to make recommendations regarding criminal records checks on individuals performing activities that require licensing by state. Directs department to report to interim committee of Legislative Assembly on work group's recommendations on or before November 30, 2012. Sunsets January 2, 2013. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## Bill Summary Report

**Summary:** Establishes criteria for coordinated care organizations. Requires that community advisory council be convened for each organization and specifies duties of council. Prescribes actuarially sound global budgeting process. Creates metrics and scoring committee to establish outcomes measures. Establishes Oregon Defensive Medicine Task Force to make recommendation for legislative concept to address practice of defensive medicine. Makes coordinated care organizations public bodies for purposes of Oregon Tort Claims Act. Makes technical and conforming amendments. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

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**Summary:** Requires Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation to establish and deposit moneys into accounts in federally insured depositories. Removes requirement but still permits excess moneys collected by corporation from insurers and state programs to be held and invested to offset future net losses. Prescribes investments to be made with excess charges that are held and invested. Authorizes corporation to borrow money and give guarantees under specified conditions. Specifies applicable provisions of public contracting code. Authorizes board of directors or executive director of corporation to contract with carriers to develop innovative health benefit plans for employees of corporation if plans are approved by Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services. Exempts such plans from Insurance Code requirements for small employer health benefit plans. Provides legislative approval of corporation business plan for health insurance exchange by repealing provisions of law enacted to require legislative approval. Makes technical corrections. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

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**Summary:** Removes sunset on Early Learning Council. Establishes Early Learning Council Fund. Expands oversight of Early Learning Council. Establishes goals and timelines for Early Learning Council to complete specified projects. Changes name of Early Childhood System Director to Early Learning System Director. Establishes Youth Development Council to oversee unified system that provides services to children and youth in manner that supports academic success and reduces criminal involvement. Establishes goals and timelines for Youth Development Council to complete specified projects. Abolishes Juvenile Crime Prevention Advisory Committee. Transfers functions of committee to Youth Development Council. Abolishes State Commission on Children and Families. Transfers functions of commission to Early Learning Council and Youth Development Council. Abolishes local commissions on children and families. Abolishes Commission for Child Care. Transfers functions to Early Learning Council. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

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**Summary:** Provides legislative approval of Oregon Health Authority proposals for coordinated care organizations and Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation business plan for health insurance exchange by repealing provisions of law enacted to require legislative approval. Makes technical corrections. Establishes criteria for licensing of massage therapy facilities. Specifies operative date of January 2, 2013. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

**Summary:** Makes coordinated care organizations local public bodies under Oregon Tort Claims Act for purposes of tort claims arising out of health services that are paid for by Oregon Health Authority. Requires organizations to impose assessments on contracting health care providers for costs associated with defending and indemnifying claims for personal injury or death made against organizations, or contracting health care providers, based on health services paid for by Oregon Health Authority. Declares emergency, effective on passage.
